As children start to feel comfortable in the school environment they also gain a sense of confidence, which can translate to better school performance. Additionally, all participants will be given school supplies to use at home, along with new books to take home and share with their families. Monthly letters and practice activities are also sent in the mail to all of our soon-to-be kindergarteners.
